I was provided an opportunity to complete work experience to develop my skills. I felt very comfortable and I found myself engaging with my Dad on a different level as we both talked about work when we got home.



Brodie's Journey After I finished school I wasn't sure what I wanted to do. I began doing some volunteer work but I wasn't sure how to make this into paid work. I also didn't know how to go about improving my confidence with meeting new people and trying new things.

The Bridge helped with social activities to build my confidence. A bit later when I was ready I began getting help for finding a job. With The Bridge's help I am now working in customer service and I love it!



Robert's Journey I came to The Bridge to get support in finding a job. I had no work history, and didn't relate well with my family and was at risk of becoming homeless. The Bridge helped me find a job which I later left to take another job that didn't work out.

I was jobless again and needed The Bridge's help. A couple of weeks later, I was working again as a dispatch worker. I'm very happy in my current job and I'm able to support myself and be independent.
